**FACULTY EXCHANGE
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
WILMINGTON UNIVERSITY AND
SAHRDAYA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY**

This Memorandum of Agreement between WILMINGTON UNIVERSITY ("WilmU"), having its principal place of business at 320 North DuPont Highway, New Castle, DE 19720 U.S.A. and Sahrdaya College Of Engineering & Technology, Kodakara, Thrissur District, Kerala 680684, India, each a "party" or "institution." wishing to establish a cooperative relationship through mutual assistance in the areas of education and research, agree as follows:

Scope of Agreement

General Scope. Each institution may offer to the other opportunities for activities and programs, such as teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, and staff development that will foster a collaborative relationship.

Goals

Provide opportunities for faculty members of WilmU and visiting institutions to foster learning opportunities for our communities.

WilmU Responsibilities (as host institution):

- Provide housing for visiting faculty for a period not to exceed two weeks at no cost.
- Provide a host faculty member during the visit. Host faculty member will be the primary contact during the visiting faculty member's visit.
- Some complimentary meals will be provided by host faculty member and other volunteers.
- Arrange for the visiting faculty member to serve as guest lecturer in preapproved courses for at least two WilmU classes. Presentations will be 60-90 minutes.
- Invite the visiting faculty member to attend faculty Senate and participate in available faculty development seminars.
- Coordinate opportunities for the visiting faculty to observe WilmU classes.

Sahrdaya College of Engineering & Technology Responsibilities (as host institution):

- Provide housing for visiting faculty, if requested, for a period not to exceed two weeks at no cost.
- Provide a host faculty member during the visit. Host faculty member will be the primary contact during the visiting faculty member's visit.
- Arrange for the visiting faculty member to serve as guest lecturer in preapproved courses for at least two Sahrdaya college classes. Presentations will be 60-90 minutes.
- Invite the visiting faculty member to attend faculty meetings and participate in available faculty development seminars.
- Coordinate opportunities for the visiting faculty to observe Sahrdaya college classes.

Visiting Faculty/Home Institution Responsibilities:

- Airfare and general expenses to be paid by the home institution or visiting faculty member.
- Coordinate the visitation period at least 60 days in advance.
- The visiting faculty member will be responsible for traveling expenses to other locations during their visit.
- Visiting faculty shall not be entitled to any benefits or compensation from the host institution, including, but not limited to, holidays, vacations, disability, insurance, pensions or retirement plans, or any other benefits or forms of compensation offered or provided by the host institution to its employees.
- Host institution will not be responsible for medical insurance, medical care or medical expenses for or incurred by visiting faculty.

General Principals which will guide the operation of this agreement:

- The visiting faculty will be on sabbatical or equivalent during the proposed semester of overseas exchange.
- The exchange will last one to two weeks as arranged in advance.
- The faculty visitor will be responsible for various costs which may include personal living expenses such as laundry, food, transportation, etc.
- Upon completion of the exchange, the visiting professor will submit a summary of his/her experience to the host university and the home university.



This agreement becomes effective on the date indicated below upon signature by all parties and shall continue in effect for three (3) years. This agreement may be terminated at any time, with or without




